Hearts Full A Pin By Brenda E. Kocher Designs

The eight Rhodes Hearts are worked with 2 plyAnchor #1028 (mauve). The six Tied Windmills are worked with 2 ply Anchor #189 (green). Be careful not to carry threads across the back of your work as these will be seen later. Work the Long Arm Cross Stitch border with 2 ply Anchor #189 (green). Start by working across


Start by working across the bottom, left to right, then work up the right side.



Continue by working up the left side, then across the top of the pin. While working the bottom part of the border, stitch the heart charm into the center.

Also shown is the Alicia Lace that is worked in all the areas around the design. It does not matter where you start, but it is important that threads are not carried across the back. Use 1 ply Anchor #1028 (mauve).


Small seed beads in the color of your choice can be placed between the hearts where you see the dots.




Materials list

- Heart charm


