## A Pin By Brenda E. Kocher Designs

## **Materials list**

5"x 5" piece of canvas in the size of your choice, such as 24 count Congress cloth, 40 count silk gauze or 22 count Hardanger fabric.

- 1 skein Anchor #45 (or DMC #814) red
- 1 skein Anchor #387 (or DMC Ecru) ecru
- 1 skein Anchor #133 (or DMC #796) blue

The number of strands you use in your needle will depend on the size canvas or fabric you use.

Work the Walnetto Stars first using Anchor #387 (ecru).

The Amadeus in the corners are worked with Anchor #133 (blue).

The Upright Cross Stitches at the tip of each Amadeus are worked with Anchor #45 (red).


The Long Arm Cross Stitch border is worked with Anchor #45 (red).


Start the Long Arm Cross Stitch in the bottom left corner of the pin, then work up the right side. Start with a new thread and continue the border going up the left side, then across the top of the pin.

Alicia Lace using Anchor #133 (blue) is worked in all the empty areas of the design. Be careful not to carry threads across the back of your work, as these will be seen later.



Walnetto Stars
Up at 1-down at 2
Up at 3-slide under1-2, down at 4
Up at 5-slide under 3-4, down at 6
Up at 7-slide under5-6, down at 8
Continue working around the star in this manner. *Note:20/23,18/21,17/22*, & 19/24 share holes.





Amadeus
The numbering for the Amadeus is shown here. Please note that the two sides have been shown separately. When the Amadeus is stitched, the two sides will share the same holes.



The numbering for the Long Arm Cross Stitch border is shown here.
